
Joshua teaches us to be strong and courageous.

JOSHUA SHIELD

This shield is made of posterboard, aluminum foil and foam stickers.

Items Needed

- 11x14" Posterboard
- Foam stars and letters
- Aluminum foil
- Scissors
- Stapler







Steps 5 and 6

Step 1 Directions

- 1. Make shield shape on a piece of posterboard. Cut out the shield shape.
- 2. Cut another strip of posterboard for the handle of the shield.
- 3. Staple handle to the back of the shield with two staples.
- 4. Cut and cover the shield with a long piece of foil.
- 5. Stick foam letters onto the shield spelling COURAGE.
- 6. Decorate with the stars.

This craft is designed to be made with adult help and supervision. Some of the material can be prepared beforehand for easier assembling by the children.
