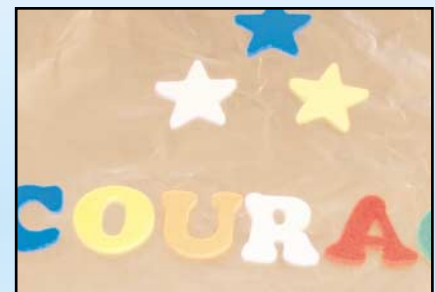
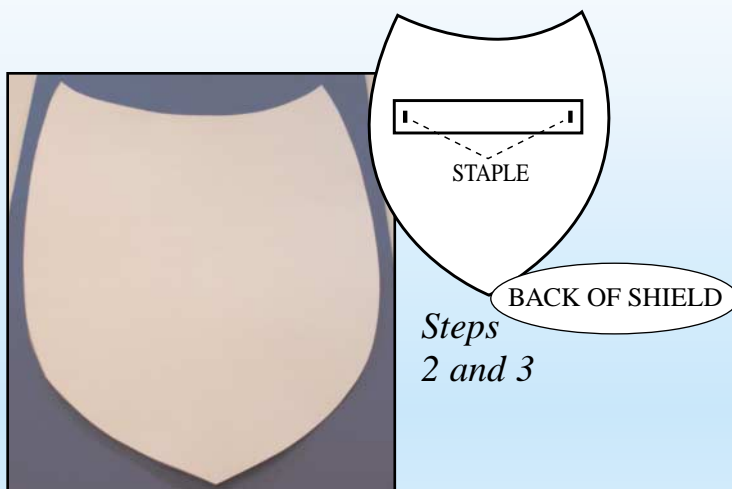
Joshua teaches us to be strong and courageous.

JOSHUA SHIELD

This shield is made of posterboard, aluminum foil and foam stickers.

Items Needed

- 11x14" Posterboard
- Aluminum foil
- Foam stars and letters
- Scissors
- Stapler



Step 1

Directions

1. Make shield shape on a piece of posterboard. Cut out the shield shape.
2. Cut another strip of posterboard for the handle of the shield.
3. Staple handle to the back of the shield with two staples.
4. Cut and cover the shield with a long piece of foil.
5. Stick foam letters onto the shield spelling COURAGE.
6. Decorate with the stars.

Steps 5 and 6

This craft is designed to be made with adult help and supervision. Some of the material can be prepared beforehand for easier assembling by the children.
