

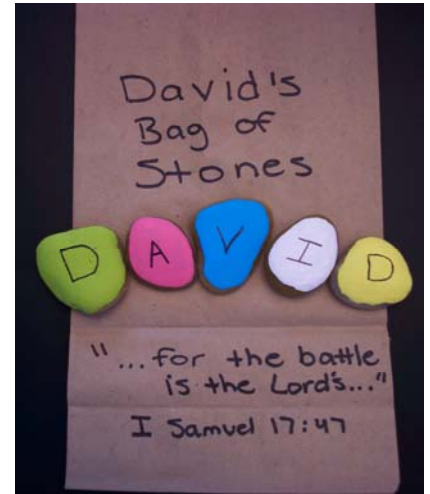
David And Goliath

Old Testament Lesson #85 • 1 Samuel 17:1-49

David's Bag Of Stones

Items Needed

- Paper Lunch Bags
- River Rocks – 5 for each child
- Permanent Markers
- Regular Markers
- Acrylic Craft Paint or other paint to use on rocks – any colors
- Old shirts or paint smocks - acrylic paint does not come out of clothing easily, or at all.
- Foam Paint Brushes
- Wax Paper
- Paper Plates
- Paper Lunch Bags



Directions

1. Have children choose 5 stones each.
2. Cut each child a piece of wax paper to paint on.
3. Put paint on paper plates (you could designate one paint brush for each color and share.)
4. Rocks may need more than one coat. (Acrylic paint dries quickly if not put on too thickly.)
5. While the paint is drying have the children write on their bags "David's Bag Of Stones" at the bottom of the bag write "For the battle is the Lord's..." I Samuel 17:47.
6. When the paint is dry write one letter of David's name on each rock with permanent marker. Be careful to not press too hard or the paint will scratch off.
