
NOAH AND THE GREAT FLOOD

BEAD RAINBOW


This rainbow is made of colorful beads that are melted together.

Items Needed


- Beads (brand used in this craft is Perlerbeads and can be found in any craft store or at Target, Wal-Mart, etc.)
- Iron
- Wax or parchment paper (also comes with bead kit)
- Any shape disk, one for each child (bead sets come with these or they can be bought separately)

Note: This craft uses a hot iron. This step must be undertaken by the teacher or an assistant or volunteer and not by children. It must be done in a safe area away from the play area and away from children. Please use extreme caution.





Steps 1 and 2



Directions

- 1. Give each child a disk; any shape will work.
- 2. Place the beads on the disks to make a rainbow.
- 3. Turn on the iron. (This step must be done by a teacher or a volunteer or assistant only and should be done in a safe place away from the play area.)
- 4. When the rainbow is finished, place a piece of parchment paper over it and iron until the beads stick together.
- 5. The directions on the bead package should be followed.
