
NOAH AND THE GREAT FLOOD

PAPER RAINBOW


This rainbow is made of colored construction paper.

Items Needed

- Construction paper rainbow colors
- Cardstock any color
- Glue sticks



Be creative! Hang words at the bottom, such as "God always keeps His promises," or decorate with glitter or glitter glue.

Directions

- 1. Draw a rainbow pattern on the cardstock with pencil or pen.
- 2. Cut out the pattern.

 Note: Steps 1 and 2 could be done before class.
- 3. Have the kids tear pieces of construction paper and glue them onto the cardstock rainbow.
- 4. Optional: Punch a hole at the top of the rainbow and attach a piece of yarn to hang it from.

This craft is designed to be made with adult help and supervision. Some of the material can be prepared beforehand for easier assembling by the children.
