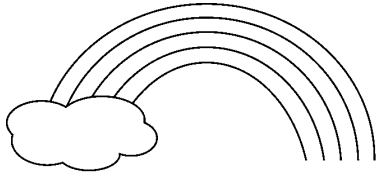


## NOAH AND THE GREAT FLOOD

Old Testament Lesson #5 • Genesis 6:5-9:19



After the flood, God sent a rainbow as a sign of His covenant.

### PAPER RAINBOW

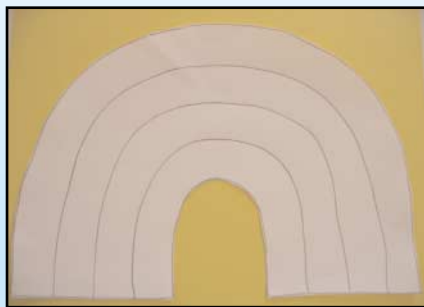
*This rainbow is made of colored construction paper.*

#### Items Needed

- Construction paper – rainbow colors
- Cardstock – any color
- Glue sticks



*Be creative! Hang words at the bottom, such as “God always keeps His promises,” or decorate with glitter or glitter glue.*

#### Directions

1. Draw a rainbow pattern on the cardstock with pencil or pen.
2. Cut out the pattern.  
Note: Steps 1 and 2 could be done before class.
3. Have the kids tear pieces of construction paper and glue them onto the cardstock rainbow.
4. Optional: Punch a hole at the top of the rainbow and attach a piece of yarn to hang it from.

*This craft is designed to be made with adult help and supervision.  
Some of the material can be prepared beforehand for easier assembling by the children.*
