GROCERY-BAG BACKPACK

This backpack has ribbon straps and is decorated with maps.


Items Needed

- 1-inch wide ribbon Construction paper
 - any color
- any color
- Brown paper grocery bag
- Glue
- Scissors
- Old maps

Be creative! Make a "buckle" for the backpack or create maps for the inside.

Directions

- 1. Fold top of paper bag over about 3.5".
- 2. Cover both sides of paper bag with construction paper up to the fold.
- 3. Make four slits in the back of the bag for the ribbon (straps): two will be 5" from the top and two will be 3" from the bottom.
- 4. Cut two strands of ribbon 3-4' each.
- 5. String the ribbon through the back to make straps. Tie the straps on the inside of the bag so they can still be adjusted.
- 6. Cut out shapes using the maps and glue them onto the backpack, or just draw maps on the backpack.



This craft is designed to be made with adult help and supervision. Some of the material can be prepared beforehand for easier assembling by the children.
